Coming soon ! Online payments for school meals (Years 3, 4 & 5)

As of January 2018 school meal payments must be paid online. Paying for meals online brings many benefits to you,

- You or your child not having to carry cash
- You can pay for meals in advance, meaning you don't have to carry change or worry about paying weekly you can pay up to a term in advance.
- View your child's balance online, meals will be in credits, 1 credit = 1 meal, the system will be updated daily.
