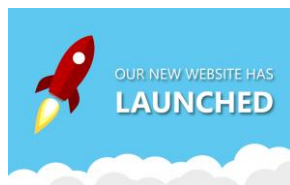
On Friday 16th October 2020, the children and staff of Camestone School are invited to wear red to show solidarity for this cause.
