How do I know if my child has coronavirus symptoms and needs to be tested?

The key symptoms are:

- A high temperature – this means feeling hot to touch on the chest or back (temperature does not need to be measured)
- A new, continuous cough – this means coughing frequently for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if someone usually has a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means not being able to smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child needs to isolate at home whilst awaiting a COVID test, there is 2-3 days work on the school hub for them to do at home. Please look in your year group folder in Remote Learning. <https://camestone.studenthub.school/> If they need to isolate for longer due to a positive test in the household, we will contact you with further support.
